General Overview

- Must sign up by February 10th.
 Sign up sheet located behind the inside bar at Kitty's
- Participants are required to prepare chili prior to event. Chili must be brought in a Crock Pot to be served at Kitty's. Electricity will be provided (One extension cord available for use per participant)
- Each participant must bring a full Crock Pot of chili for guests and judges to taste/sample.
- Registration form filled out and turned in day of event (extra copies will be available the day of)

Ingredients

Use your favorite recipe, with or without meat, with or without beans, as hot or mild as you'd like. Meat may be beef, pork, lamb, chicken, turkey, or wild game. Veggie (meatless) is okay as well. If peanuts or peanut oil is used, please provide and display a warning sing. All ingredients must be pre-cooked prior to the even, chili is to be brought "ready to eat"

- Electricity/extension cord for crock pot
- Gloves
- 2 oz sampling cups
- Napkins
- · Bucket with sanitizer
- Toppings (cheese, onion, sour cream)

Must be supplied by participants:

- Crockpot
- Ingredients for chili
- Utensil to serve chili
